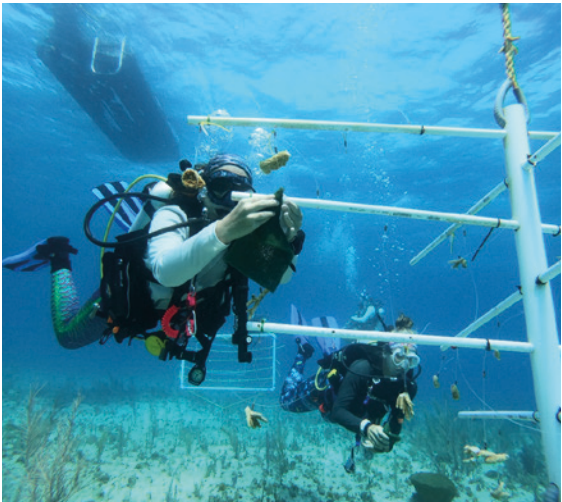


COMMUNITY PROSPERITY

From the outset, Anse Chastanet and Jade Mountain have focused on creating opportunities for Saint Lucians to benefit from tourism. With a 99% Saint Lucian team and more than 500 employees, the resorts are among the largest employers in the island’s south-west. Furniture and fittings are crafted or sourced locally and guest excursions are curated to introduce visitors to small, independently run enterprises. Local artistry is celebrated through the sale and promotion of local artworks and handmade crafts in resort, while menus feature organic produce from the resorts’ own farm and from nearby farmers who have taken part in training and mentoring schemes run by the resorts.

EDUCATION & EMPOWERMENT

Named after the nearby town of Old Road, home to over 80% of Curtain Bluff’s team, the Old Road Fund has been supporting local education and opportunity since 1974. What began as free tennis lessons for local children has grown into a leading private foundation in Antigua and Barbuda, investing over \$3 million in education and skills development. The fund provides scholarships from primary school through to university, including overseas study to support young people in pursuing their educational and career ambitions. Former recipients have gone on to become national leaders, including a senator and the island’s Minister of Tourism, while many others now hold positions within the hotel itself, reflecting the long-term value of investing in education.



RESTORING REEFS, BUILDING RESILIENCE

Off the coast of South Caicos, Salterra is helping to restore the island’s coral reefs and strengthen their resilience for the future. Through the South Caicos Coral Reef Consortium – which Salterra co-founded alongside a group of local institutes – scientists and students are researching, replanting and monitoring coral growth to improve reef health. Guests can join guided visits aboard Adventures by Salterra boats to meet the researchers, tour the coral lab and learn about restoration techniques in progress. Certified divers can also assist with coral planting under expert supervision, gaining a deeper understanding of marine conservation.

CULTIVATING CHANGE THROUGH FOOD

Calabash is an active supporter of Grenada’s Slow Food movement, illustrating how local food traditions shape both the guest experience and the island’s cultural identity. The hotel’s menus are built around locally available ingredients: fruits, vegetables and spices grown using both traditional and environmentally minded approaches. Longstanding relationships with small-scale farmers and local fishermen link the hotel with the island’s producers and the culinary traditions rooted in their work. Organic waste is composted to feed the kitchen garden, while seaweed cleared from nearby beaches is turned into natural fertiliser, creating a circular system that reuses natural materials on-site.



PRESERVING MEXICO’S LIVING HERITAGE

Journey Mexico partners with local organisations to support responsible tourism. Its Positive Impact Fund adds a small contribution to each booking, directing these funds to grassroots NGOs focused on community development, biodiversity protection and cultural heritage. One such initiative supports the restoration of the traditional chinampa farming system in Mexico City, a network of floating plots first developed by the Aztecs. Abandoned chinampas are being restored, ancient agro-ecological practices taught through local programmes and families educated on environmentally minded farming approaches. By helping to revive this centuries-old system, the project sits alongside community efforts to keep traditional practices active and to celebrate a unique aspect of Mexico’s living heritage.

A MORE SUSTAINABLE BROCHURE

We have taken a number of steps to reduce the carbon footprint of this brochure. We have chosen not to date it or to price our itineraries, giving the brochure a longer shelf life and avoiding any wastage of out-of-date stock. Plus the brochure is printed using vegetable-based inks on paper that has come from well-managed, FSC®-certified forests and other controlled sources.

What’s more, we have paid to carbon balance the paper through the World Land Trust, which will use our contribution to support projects protecting threatened tropical forests, helping to reduce deforestation and preserve vital ecosystems.

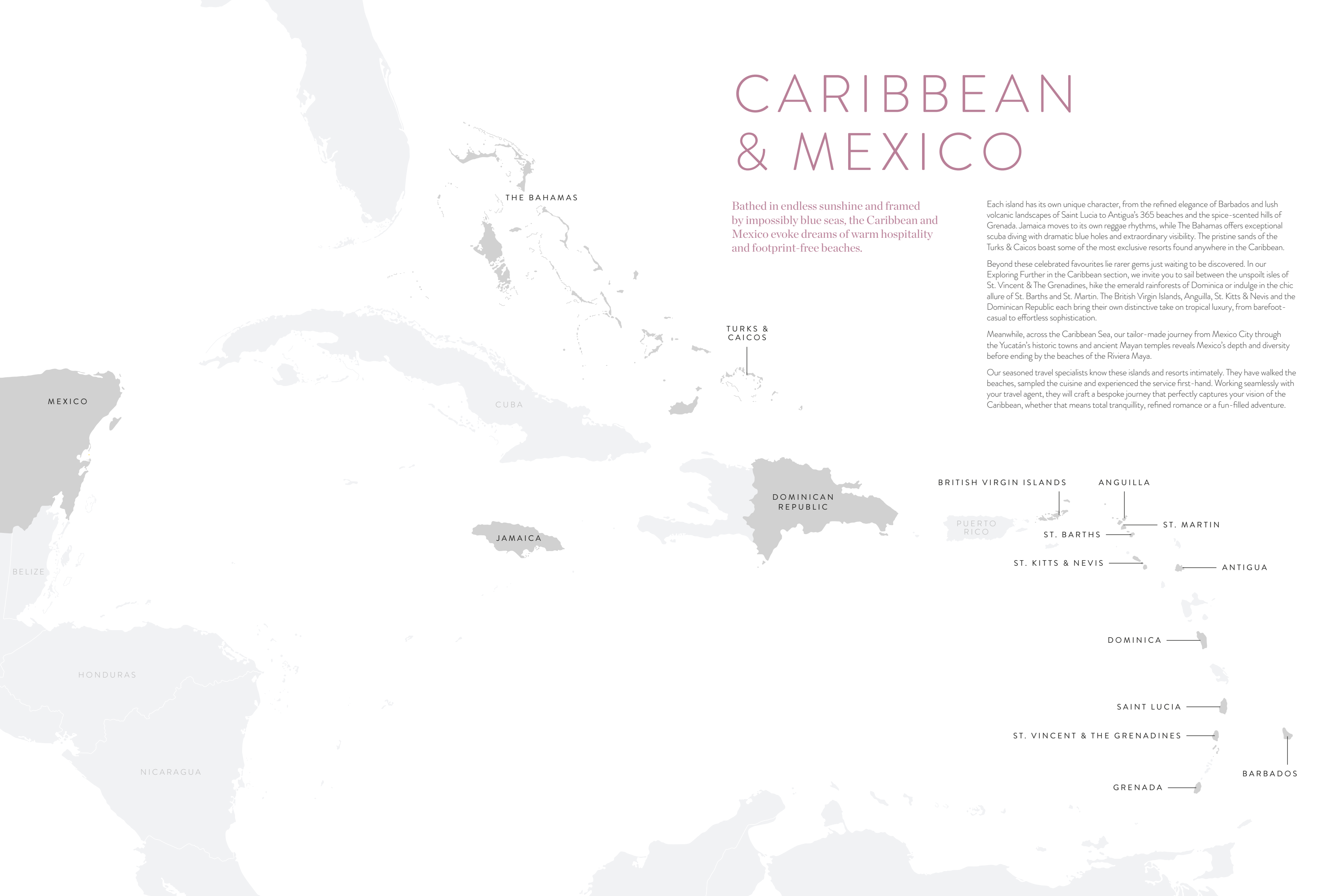
Bathed in endless sunshine and framed by impossibly blue seas, the Caribbean and Mexico evoke dreams of warm hospitality and footprint-free beaches.

The natural sights here are remarkable, notably the World Heritage-recognised Gros and Petit Pitons: two dramatic peaks in the south of the island that can be scaled under guidance. From volcanic origins, this picturesque island landscape is brimming with lush dense rainforests and beaches steeped in character, all against a backdrop of verdant mountains.

Drive into the heart of a volcano, visit the sulphur springs, photograph the most awe-inspiring wild birds, orchids and ferns or take an exhilarating canopy zip-wire over some of these remarkable sights. Saint Lucia is ideal for varied and challenging mountain bike rides and is situated amid some of the most breathtaking diving and snorkelling sites in the whole of the Caribbean. The local gastronomy incorporates French influences with food and drink festivals, street parties and local cultural evenings offering a fascinating insight into life on this beautiful island. Held at the beginning of May each year, the Saint Lucia Jazz & Arts Festival is a highly anticipated event in the Caribbean calendar and is not to be missed.

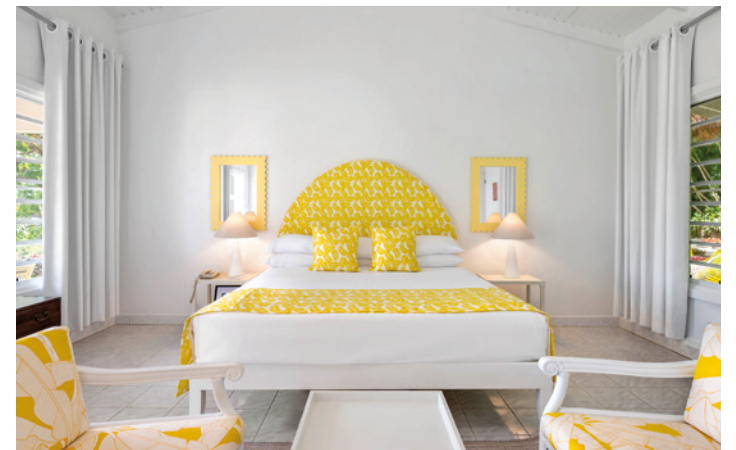
