Carao restaurant is one of three in the resort and offers an artistic twist on traditional Mexican cuisine on the hotel's highest peak. Mediterranean- and Pan-American-inspired Alma is more causal in style but no less impressive in its setting, while the Jetty Beach Club rounds out proceedings with fresh-off-the-boat seafood and Mexican light lunches.

Thankfully, there's a long list of activities to help counter all the eating. Highlights include whale watching in season (Dec-Mar), swimming in pools that appear to defy gravity, learning to play polo, hiking through the rainforest, and taking yourself off to the One&Only Spa, where options include meditation practices, healing-flow yoga and Tata Harper treatments.


WHEN TO GO

Malaysia

Guests can choose from either Rainforest Suites ensconced in the jungle canopy or Ocean Suites framed by hypnotic sea views, all with terraces, plunge pools and private butler service. To this you can add two larger Grand Suites and the showstopping Villa One, a four-bedroom, split-level beachfront fantasy with a 27-metre pool and a dedicated spa room.

Fronted by a sweep of bone-white sand, Ember Beach Club offers up-beat music, colourful cocktails and an elevated take on barbecues on the beach. Other dining options include a high-end Japanese restaurant and an East-meets-West eatery where ingredients are sourced from local organic farms and the chef's own kitchen garden.

There's also more to do here than you could ever fit into a single stay, with highlights ranging from a visit to the Chenot Spa, whose treatments combine the best of science, beauty, wellness and relaxation, to golf, tennis, bonfires on the beach and ascending by rope to viewing platforms hidden within the highest treetop canopies.


For the perfect city and beach combination, fly direct from the UK to sizzling Singapore for a couple of nights in the food capital of Asia before transferring by road to Desaru Coast, just two and a half hours away.

WHEN TO GO

Desaru Coast sees plenty of sunshine even during the rainy season, with temperatures averaging 32°C.

Monsoon winds usually blow in between November and February, making the water more murky. The hottest months are from June until August.







Described as the jewel of Europe's newest riviera, One&Only Portonovi is unashamedly sumptuous. Resplendent at the entrance of Boka Bay, a fjord-like idyll on the Adriatic Sea, it offers chic waterfront villas, worldclass dining, a pioneering Chenot Espace Wellness Centre and spectacular sea views from almost every angle.

Rooms and suites have an inherent sense of space and privacy, connecting with the outdoors via floor-to-ceiling windows, balconies or terraces, with ground-floor rooms leading directly into the gardens. Two-bedroom suites are perfect for families. The threebedroom Villa One forms its own escapist world, complete with bar, wine cave, spa room, garden and hydrotherapy pool, while the ten Signature Villas are unrivalled in Montenegro.
