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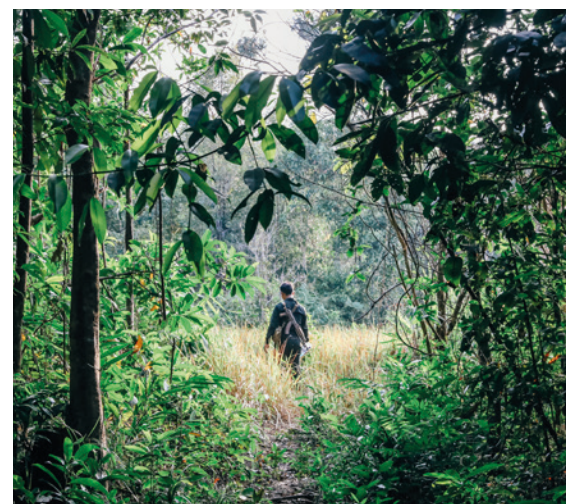
SUPPORTING RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

As a tour operator working towards our own sustainability goals, we seek to partner with hotels and excursion providers that share our passion for responsible tourism – those striving to minimise their carbon footprint, support local communities and respect the cultures and environments in which they operate. Here, we shine a spotlight on some key sustainability initiatives and on the efforts of our partners in South East Asia.



COMMUNITY AT THE HEART OF HOSPITALITY

Established in 2004, The Sarojin Khao Lak Community Fund reflects the resort's deep commitment to the people and environment that surround it. From restoring the local fishing fleet to supporting school construction, healthcare, animal welfare and local infrastructure, the fund contributes to a wide range of projects that aim to uplift the community and help regenerate. The majority of the fund is given directly to local causes, while through the 'One Booking One Tree' scheme, The Sarojin supports the planting of mangroves, one of nature's natural carbon stores, by planting a minimum of one tree per booking made, with guests invited to join tree-planting activities during their stay.



PROTECTING BIODIVERSITY

Deep in the heart of southern Cambodia lies the largest tract of uninterrupted rainforest left in South East Asia. This remarkable wilderness is a biodiversity hotspot, home to more than 50 rare and endangered species. Threatened by illegal mining, logging and poaching, this fragile ecosystem inspired the creation of Shinta Mani Wild. The hotel provides employment opportunities for local residents (70% of staff are from the local village, many of them former poachers and loggers) and works with conservation partners to fund forest rangers and ranger stations, monitor wildlife and support reforestation. Every stay here contributes to ongoing conservation efforts, with guests even invited to join rangers on their patrols.



FISH FOR THE FUTURE

Fish for the Future is a marine conservation initiative (part of The Datai Pledge) dedicated to supporting the health of local coral reefs and promoting sustainable fishing practices. Working alongside marine biologists, local fishermen and conservation partners, the programme focuses on reef restoration, marine biodiversity research and community education. Guests are invited to learn about ocean conservation, join coral-planting sessions and discover more about the efforts to understand tourism helps safeguard Langkawi's delicate marine ecosystems. By supporting these initiatives, Fish for the Future helps to contribute to the island's coastal communities, and encourage a closer relationship between people and nature.

EMPOWERING WOMEN

Gain a deeper understanding of Balinese culture by visiting the Women's Centre in the village of Payangan. The centre was established by Ibu Sari to provide a safe space for divorced women, who are often stigmatised in their communities, empowering them with skills in cooking, catering, tailoring and salesmanship. By visiting, you'll be helping to support the centre and the women it serves. You'll also learn about the important role women play in Balinese life and hear Ibu Sari's own inspirational story. During your visit, you can take part in two workshops of your choice, from Balinese cooking and batik making to herbal tea brewing and crafting canang sari, the beautiful daily offerings seen throughout Bali.



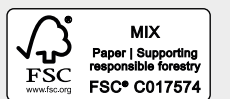
RESPECTING GIANTS: UNDERSTANDING ETHICAL ELEPHANT TOURISM

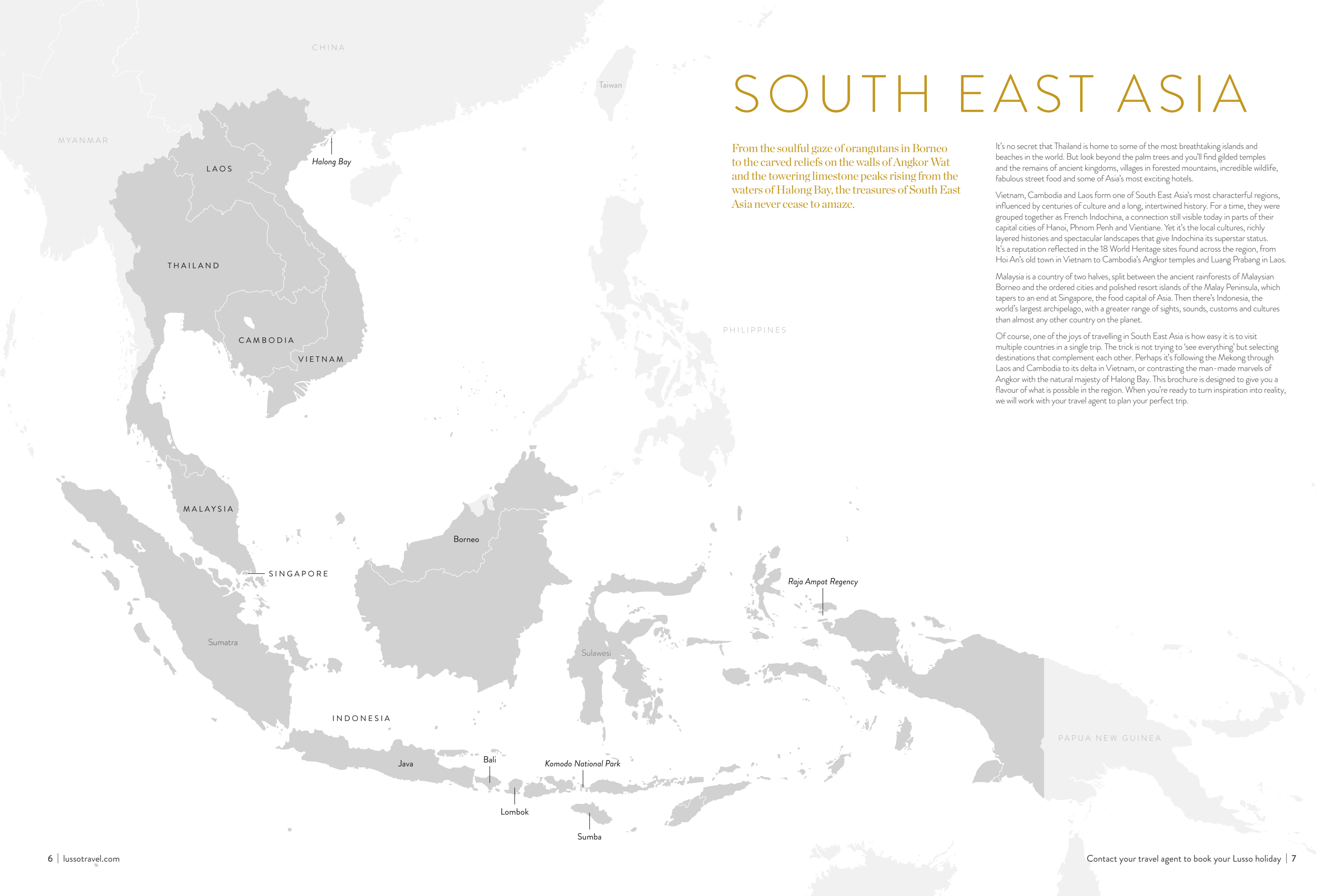
Elephants have long been part of Asia's cultural and working heritage, but changes in industries such as logging have left many elephants and their mahouts seeking new livelihoods. This has created complex challenges around welfare and conservation. At Lusso, we believe elephants belong in the wild and that observing them in their natural habitat offers travellers the most meaningful experience. However, we also recognise that responsible tourism can play a role in supporting ethical elephant sanctuaries. By working only with trusted partners who prioritise welfare, rehabilitation and education, we help guests make informed choices that safeguards both elephants and the people who care for them.

A MORE SUSTAINABLE BROCHURE

We have taken a number of steps to reduce the carbon footprint of this brochure. We have chosen not to date it or to price our itineraries, giving the brochure a longer shelf life and avoiding any wastage of out-of-date stock. The brochure is printed using vegetable-based inks on paper that has come from well-managed, FSC®-certified forests and other controlled sources.

What's more, we have paid to carbon balance the paper through the World Land Trust, which will use our contribution to support projects protecting threatened tropical forests, helping to reduce deforestation and preserve vital ecosystems.





SOUTH EAST ASIA

From the soulful gaze of orangutans in Borneo to the carved reliefs on the walls of Angkor Wat and the towering limestone peaks rising from the waters of Halong Bay, the treasures of South East Asia never cease to amaze.

It's no secret that Thailand is home to some of the most breathtaking islands and beaches in the world. But look beyond the palm trees and you'll find gilded temples and the remains of ancient kingdoms, villages in forested mountains, incredible wildlife, fabulous street food and some of Asia's most exciting hotels.

Vietnam, Cambodia and Laos form one of South East Asia's most characterful regions, influenced by centuries of culture and a long, intertwined history. For a time, they were grouped together as French Indochina, a connection still visible today in parts of their capital cities of Hanoi, Phnom Penh and Vientiane. Yet it's the local cultures, richly layered histories and spectacular landscapes that give Indochina its superstar status. It's a reputation reflected in the 18 World Heritage sites found across the region, from Hoi An's old town in Vietnam to Cambodia's Angkor temples and Luang Prabang in Laos.

Malaysia is a country of two halves, split between the ancient rainforests of Malaysian Borneo and the ordered cities and polished resort islands of the Malay Peninsula, which tapers to an end at Singapore, the food capital of Asia. Then there's Indonesia, the world's largest archipelago, with a greater range of sights, sounds, customs and cultures than almost any other country on the planet.

Of course, one of the joys of travelling in South East Asia is how easy it is to visit multiple countries in a single trip. The trick is not trying to 'see everything' but selecting destinations that complement each other. Perhaps it's following the Mekong through Laos and Cambodia to its delta in Vietnam, or contrasting the man-made marvels of Angkor with the natural majesty of Halong Bay. THAILAND

Join Thailand's warm and welcoming locals in their love of the country's way of life. From blissful beaches to sacred monuments, contemporary comforts to traditional customs, Thailand is a colourful combination of character, cuisine and culture.

Few places on earth inspire exotic adventures quite like Thailand, with its wealth of stunning scenery and endless opportunities to island hop in style. The southwest islands of the Andaman Sea create those classic picture postcard panoramas of hidden bays, turquoise seas and small isles rising like cliffs across the horizon. This vision of Thailand can become a reality with scenic boat journeys linking an array of islands that each offer something unique, yet authentically Thai.

DAYS 1-4: KHAO LAK

Arrive in Phuket, and take a short transfer north to Khao Lak. Known for its long, sweeping beaches and local villages, it's a place to relax, unwind, and embrace a slower pace of life. Here, you will stay at The Sarojin for four nights in boutique beachfront style. During your stay, choose a full-day boat trip to the Similan Islands, for some of Asia's best snorkelling, or head to Khao Sok National Park for the jungle and lake of 'Little Guilin'. To mark the beginning of your island adventure, a signature dinner by the waterfall is also included.

DAYS 5-7: KOH YAO NOI

Take the boat into beautiful Phang Nga Bay to Koh Yao Noi island. Stay for three nights at 9 Hornbills Tented Camp, a wonderful glamping experience set on the hillside of the island and featuring panoramic views. This serene island will treat you to laid-back days spent spotting the rare hornbills, from which the luxury camp takes its name. Also included is a half-day boat trip to James Bond Island, plus a Thai cooking class in the local village.

DAYS 8-10: KRABI

Jump on a boat across the bay to Krabi, known for its sheer limestone cliffs and lively atmosphere. Stay at The Shellsea hotel for three nights, situated on the fine sands of secluded Fossil Beach. Enjoy the spa, try yoga or a Thai boxing class, and then take the short hop to Ao Nang.

DAY 11-14: KOH LANTA

Venture south by boat past the larger, less developed islands of the bay to Koh Lanta, where you will stay at Pimalai Resort and Spa for three nights. The hotel's striking stretch of beach is one of the best in Thailand, and certainly a focal point of the property, as well as its dramatic hillside panoramas. Relax, enjoy the variety of watersports on offer, and visit charming Koh Lanta town. You can also spend half a day at Following Giants, a wonderful ethical elephant sanctuary, and immerse in a beachfront cooking class for a quintessential Thai experience.

Return by boat to Krabi for your departure, or extend the trip for a few days by heading to the twin islands Koh Phi Phi, before completing the loop back to Phuket.

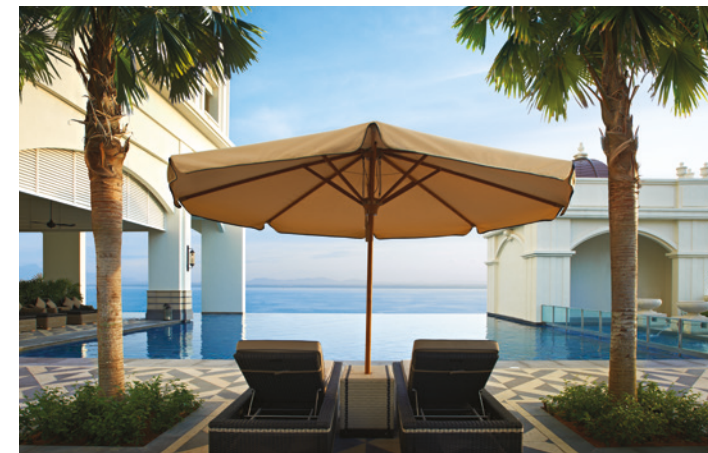

DAYS 1-2: KUALA LUMPUR

Arrive in Kuala Lumpur for a two-night stay at the Shangri-La Hotel. Explore both the older areas and the modern city landmarks, including the Petronas Towers, or take an optional day trip to historic Malacca.

DAY 3: KOTA KINABALU

Fly across the South China Sea to the island of Borneo, with an overnight stay at the luxury Shangri-La Tanjung Aru, set on the waterfront of this bustling port city.



DAYS 4-5: SEPILOK AND SUKAU, KINABATANGAN RIVER

Fly south to Sepilok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre, arriving in time for the morning feeding of these semi-wild orangutans, alongside a visit to the orangutan nursery. Afterwards, continue to the Borneo Sun Bear Conservation Centre, where you can learn about the world’s smallest bear.

In the afternoon, travel by boat along the Kinabatangan River and deep into the jungle to Sukau Rainforest Lodge. From here, explore the rainforest with expert nature guides, including a dawn boat trip to reveal exotic birdlife, a boardwalk trek among endemic plants, and sunset cruise on the river in search of flying foxes, macaques, and more. There’s also time to relax and listen to the calls of the jungle.

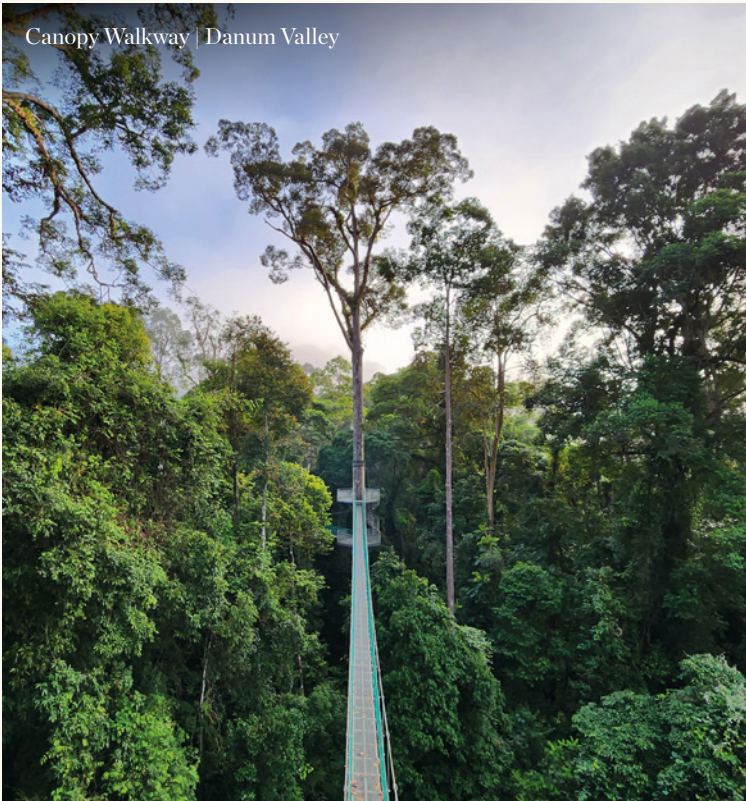
DAYS 6-7: BORNEO RAINFOREST LODGE

Travel into the million-year-old primary rainforest of the Danum Valley for two nights at Borneo Rainforest Lodge. Indulge in tranquil lunches, enjoy afternoon guided nature trails, and be sure to traverse the 20-metre-high canopy walkway for a bird’s-eye view of the jungle. After dinner, be sure to join the night drive or night walk to look for nocturnal wildlife.

DAYS 8-12: GAYA ISLAND

Fly back to Kota Kinabalu and continue to Gaya Island Resort for a four-night stay, with villa-style rooms hidden in the canopy and views of Mount Kinabalu in the distance. The resort has a spa village, premium dining and access to protected waters, along with a marine centre that includes a sea turtle rescue programme. On Day 13, you will transfer to the airport for your flight home.

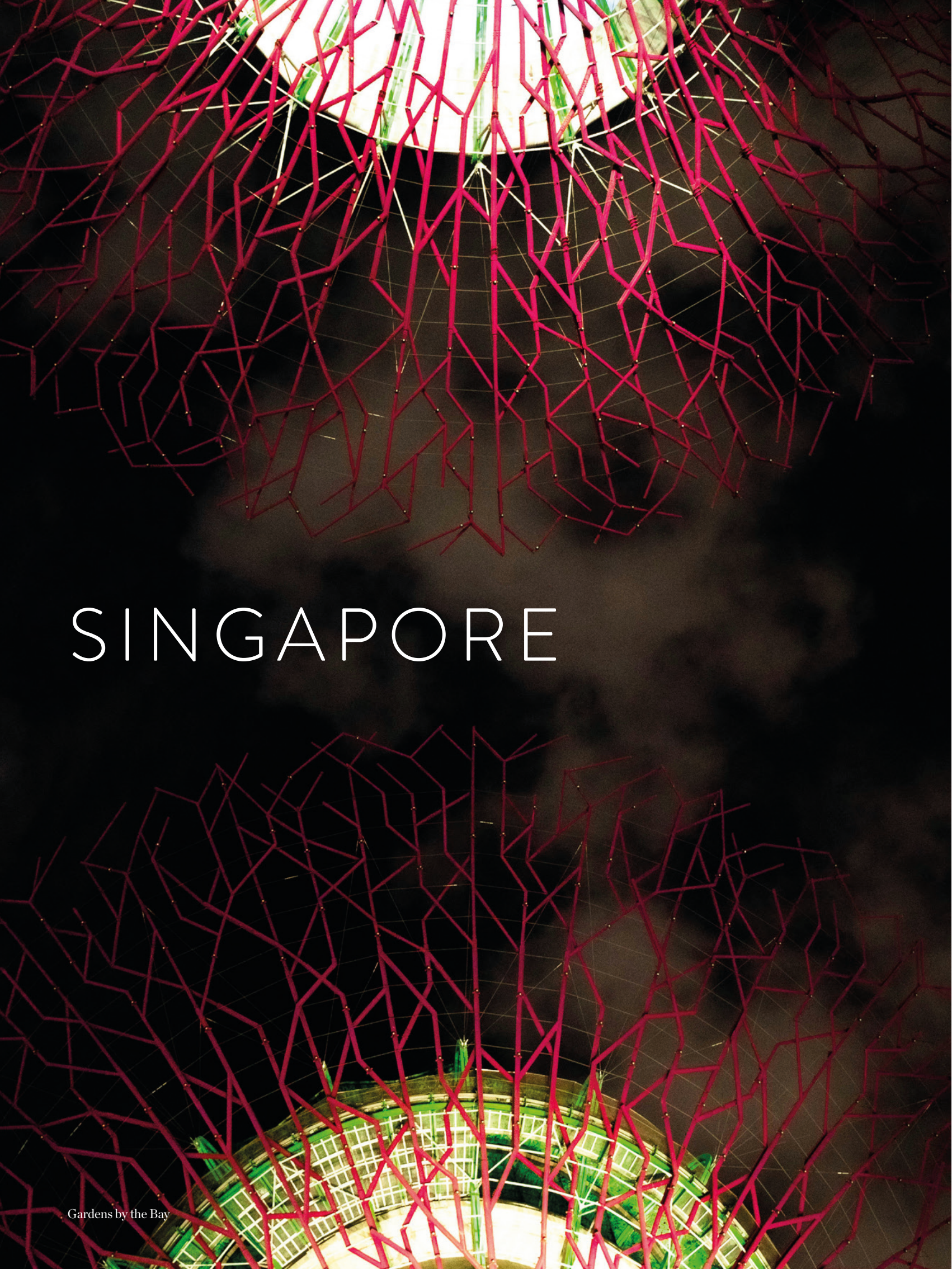
Gaya Island Marine Reserve
